Dear Parents,

We are ready to begin registration for English Rose Summer Camp 2017! We are looking forward this year to a new camp adventure. You can sign up for as little as a week or as much as the whole summer. This year we have TWO sets of themes. One for our Toddler, Pre-K and Kindergarten Campers, and one set for our 1st through 5th grade campers. The grade applicable for your child is the grade that they have just *completed*.

Campers will also engage in water play during our warm summer days. Our game room will be back again for campers to enjoy all sorts of fun games and activities both inside and out! We will be undertaking many fun crafts and activities as they relate to our weekly themes. We will also offer our cooking and science room. At the end of our summer program we will be hosting our “end of camp performance for parents and family members”, as well as our penny carnival designed by our campers. Our School Age campers will also go on field trips to various places. (more information will follow) We will also have some special in house events for our campers of all ages.

Our off-site field trips for Grades 1st-5th will include Kelders Farm, Movies and Bowling – in-house specials for school-age will include – 2 separate weeks of our water slide, Mad Science, a Dino-Dig and Macaroni the Clown.

For our younger campers, we will have the following in-house specials – Pats Pals, 2 separate weeks of our waterslide, Mad Science and Macaroni the Clown.

We will also have the opportunity for campers to purchase a special lunch each Friday of camp – pizza, hamburgers & hotdogs, Chinese food etc. – details to follow
